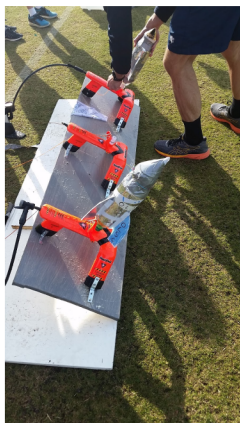
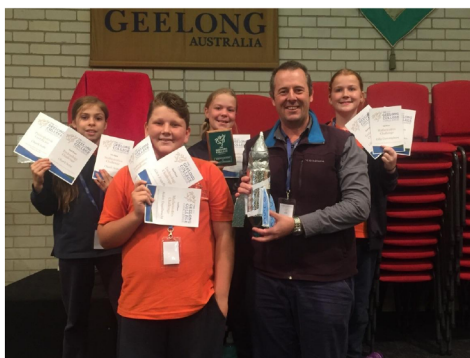
MACKILLOP COLLEGE INFORMATION EVENING YEAR 7 2019
