## **Family Art Installation Bollards**



We are commencing an exciting project to celebrate the families within our school community. On the last Thursday of Term 2 all children completed an invitation (copies are on the newsletter and on the P&F Facebook page) inviting families to a workshop on Tuesday 25th July from 1.30 - 3.00pm in the afternoon.

We want every family to complete a bollard for our outdoor art installation around the grounds of the school.

The image on the left is the 1st draft of 1.2 metre x 40cm bollard that will recognise Fr Frank's role and contribution to the school and parish community. Important information e.g. Fr Frank's country of origin - Malta- and his adopted country Australia are represented as are photos of the many activities that have been part of his service to our community. (On show in school foyer). The family bollard will be on similar lines.

We are asking families to collect photos of family members and events that have been important in your lives as well as activities you have engaged in as a family. The bollards will be a collage of photos of your family including:

- extended family
- celebrations
- your home
- a map of family origin
- country of origin flag
- national costume
- famous landmarks
- words to describe your family
- special awards, medals & certificates
- favourite foods etc etc etc

The possibilities are endless!

The family name will be down the right hand side of the bollard. Families will need to be creative and prepare their family name.

Each bollard will need approximately 40 –50 photos that will be pasted as a collage over the bollard - these can be photocopied and resized as in Fr Frank's bollard. We are holding workshops where we invite families to come along and work on their bollard with their children. We ask you to bring your photos or photocopies of them to the workshops. The workshop on the 25th July is the first of a number of opportunities to complete the bollard. The items will be glued to the base with PVA glue and then finished with a Marine Varnish finish to protect them from the weather as they will be outside in the grounds on completion.

Families who are unable to attend any of the workshops with their children are asked to contact the office so arrangements can be made for you to collect your bollard, complete it at home and return it to school. In these cases your children will work on a paper version at school to plan the layout of the family bollard.

The official launch of our family art installation is on the OLSC Feast Day, Thursday August 31 which parents are invited to attend. The day will include Mass, BBQ and multi-cultural activities. The final details of this day will be advertised in the newsletter but please put the date in your diaries.

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
